



American Legion Auxiliary's California Girls State Alumnae Foundation 2018 Summer Internship FAQ Sheet

What?

This internship will focus on developing a range of skills that strengthen the resume of one young alumna, making them a more competitive applicant to career opportunities and leadership position as an undergraduate and beyond. Leading up to, and during the session of California Girls State, the Intern will help the Girls State Alumnae Foundation (GSAF) staff promote Girls State by developing promotional videos, working with GSAF staff to engage with social media, and more, all of which lead up to the annual GSAF summer fundraiser. Most importantly, the Intern will be the young face of a recent alumna that 2019 Girls Staters will look to as a professional image of their future endeavors.

Requirements

You must be:

- A 2017 Girls State Alumnae (no other alumnae from other years will be considered)
- Able to attend the 2019 Girls State Session to be held June 24-June 29, 2019

Disclaimer : Applicants **do not** have to be interested in careers in politics/government, communications, PR, etc. Communication will also be sourced through electronic devices leading up to the Girls State session. Location is not a deciding factor in applicants.

Benefits

Not only is the intern able to reconnect to the magic of Girls State, but they will also receive a stipend of \$2,000. GSAF provides great exposure to the nonprofit world and, with its diverse staff, strengthens the networking capabilities of the intern. Additionally, to help facilitate the intern's skill development there will be a series of professional workshops leading up to the session of Girls State that focuses on skills such as: speech-giving, excel use, video production, interview skills, resume development, and much more. Our goal is to provide a well, thought-out developmental internship that allows the intern to excel during their time with GSAF, and be a competitive applicant to other career-related internships and leadership positions throughout their undergraduate career and beyond.

Difference between GSAF Intern and JCs?

The GSAF intern is associated with the Alumnae Foundation, a nonprofit organization affiliated with the American Legion Auxiliary's California Girls State. While JCs have just graduated from high school and are responsible for tasks assigned by Girls State staff, the GSAF intern is not only older, but has tasks that promote GSAF and Girls State, the summer fundraiser, and beyond. Although the internship will be present during the 2018 Girls State sessions, intern tasks will be widely different from the JCs and will scope beyond the session of Girls State.
